



Bronze model of "Lublin at the turn of the 16th and 17th centuries"

As part of the cross-border project "New life of the old city: revitalization of monuments of historical and cultural heritage of Lutsk and Lublin." (Cross-border Cooperation Program Poland-Belarus-Ukraine 2014-2020) implemented by Lublin in partnership with the Ukrainian city of Lutsk, a model of Lublin from the turn of the 16th and 17th centuries was created. It is made of bronze in a scale of 1:500. The model was placed on a stone plinth at Łokietka's Square from Królewska Street, which allows to compare the present view with the historical reconstruction. It has been adapted to the needs of people with disabilities and contains descriptions in Polish, English, German, Ukrainian and Braille. The urban model is a new element of the city space and another tourist attraction of Lublin.
